Greetings from the Farmington Libraries!

Now, at the beginning of summer, I would like to take a moment to reflect on the past year and all of the challenges and hardships that we needed to cope with due to the pandemic. The staff at the Farmington Libraries, as well as libraries across the state and the nation, responded to the COVID-19 pandemic in unprecedented ways. Curbside pickup, grab-andgo services and online programs became the norm. Fortunately, we seem to have turned the corner and we are now fully open to the public, allowing access to all of our meeting and study room spaces at full capacity. In addition, we are planning an exciting series of summer reading programs for all ages and interests starting with our **Summer Reading Kickoff** event at the Main Library on June 20. Both Dana and Ida will be serving for three-year terms. I am also pleased to welcome Heidi Schulz-Vendrella, our new Adult Programming Coordinator, to the Libraries. Heidi has been planning a full series of informative, interactive and entertaining programs for adults this summer and fall, including our ever-popular **Garmany Music Series** concerts at the Main and Barney Libraries.

I would also like to acknowledge and thank Terry Matava, our Interlibrary Loan Coordinator, for 35 years of dedicated service. Terry, who retired on April 28th, loved sharing her knowledge of Farmington history with local residents, especially those doing research in the **Farmington Room**. It is amazing to think that when Terry started her library career in 1987, the Internet was in its infancy and we were just beginning to dip our toe into the world of information technology. Google, which continues to dominate the search engine market (used by 92.47% of those using a search engine to find information as of June 2021), was not launched until 1998. DVDs were not released until 1996. In 1987, cell phones were as large as bricks and cost about 50 cents a minute to use. Tom Wolfe's *The Bonfire of the Vanities* and Tom Clancy's *Patriot Games* topped the New York Times bestseller list. While I will not try to predict what will be happening 35 years hence in 2057, I am certain the Farmington Libraries will continue to serve the needs of everyone in our community, helping to fulfill our mission to provide free access to services, experiences and resources that offer opportunities to explore, create and share ideas.

Our **Wacky Wednesday** evenings showcasing family performances will return this year, including the Energy in Motion mobile science lab, CT Birds of Prey, Ed Pop Magic & Comedy Show, and Riverside Reptiles, along with tons of other fun activities and reading incentives. We will also close out the town's summer concert series with the Jester Jim Show on August 25 – this beatboxing, juggling, and comedy show is highly entertaining.

The Children's Department has been working with 4D Design to reorganize our space.
